Probate litigation may involve an occupant in wrongful possession of real property belonging to a trust, estate, or conservatorship estate. Many attorneys are quick to say that such occupant may be removed by an unlawful detainer action or a Probate Code section 850 petition. Depending on the type of occupant and the way in which the claims are sought, however, an attorney may fall into an easy trap of filing the wrong type of proceeding or not recovering the maximum relief available.
