In 1984 Andy Warhol copied photograph taken by Lynn Goldsmith of the musician Prince for a series of silkscreened prints, only one of which was authorized. After Prince's death in 2016 a different print was published by Vanity Fair, and Goldsmith discovered the "Prince Series." She contacted the Warhol Foundation, the Foundation filed suit, and this fascinating fair use case began.

Three amici brief authors will explain the history of the case and the arguments presented. This is an incredible opportunity to learn about the case that will decide the future of fair use!
