By affixing my signature to this contract, I agree as follows:

1. Release (injury to myself or to my personal property)
That I release any and all officials, agents, sponsors and their employees of The Bar Association of San Francisco and its officials and employees or any others affiliated with this basketball league for any injury to myself or my heirs or successors in interest arising from my participation in this adult basketball league.

2. Hold Harmless (injury to others or other personal property)

That I will indemnify and hold harmless any and all officials, agents, sponsors and their employees of The Bar Association of San Francisco and its officials and employees or any others affiliated with this basketball league from any loss or liability (bodily injuries or death, and/or for damage to property, including the loss of use thereof) which results or is alleged to result from my participation in this adult basketball league.

3. Player Responsibility for Procuring InsuranceThat I am fully aware this basketball league, The Bar Association of San Francisco, and its officials, agents, sponsors and their employees, and its officials and employees or any others affiliated with this basketball league carries NO medical insurance for any participant. I understand that I am solely responsible for securing my own insurance and that my team is responsible for securing its own insurance.

4. Assumption of risk

That I assume all risks involved in my participation in The Bar Association of San Francisco basketball league which will be held at UC Hastings and that I recognize that I am solely responsible for my decision to participate in any game in this adult basketball league. The above release stated in section 1 includes but is not limited to, a release (1) for the maintenance or condition of the playing field (2) for the condition of appurtenances thereto (bleachers, scorekeepers table, etc.) and (3) any equipment used and supplied by the BASF league. (4) any lost or stolen property while participating or attending the game(s).

5. Release for photographs taken during BASF Basketball League games
I grant permission to The Bar Association of San Francisco to use photographs and/or video images taken during the league, to be used for promotional purposes. I also understand that the Bar Association of San Francisco retains the right to use photographs and/or video images taken of me and my teammates at the Bar Association of San Francisco basketball league for publicity and advertising purposes.

I. Design

- The league will operate for approximately 9-10 weeks.
- There will be a minimum of six teams, with 8-10 players/team and a maximum of twelve teams.

II. Rules

- Game Play will be five on five with two twenty minute halves of running time. Time will be stopped for
 timeouts (each team receives two per half at 30 seconds) and by referee discretion. The game clock will
 stop during the last two minutes of the second half for whistles. In addition, each player present during
 league games must play at least 10 minutes and players must play a minimum of two games in the regular
 season to be qualified to play in the playoffs.
- Halftime There will be a five minute half-time in which teams will switch sides of the court.
- Warm-Up Teams will be allowed a three minute warm-up between games but are encouraged to warm-up through other modes.
- Overtime In the event of a tied score at the end of regulation, an overtime session of two minutes (running time until the final minute) will be played. If the game is still tied, the teams will have a jump ball at center court and the outcome will then be decided by sudden death (i.e. which ever team scores the first basket). In the playoffs there will be no sudden death and the game will continue to have overtime session of two minutes.
- Forfeits Teams may play with four players. However, a team having three or fewer players will be required to forfeit. If a team forfeits, the score will be 40-0 as a reflection and the team that shows may use the hour as practice or play pickup.
- Fouls Each player is allowed five personal fouls, with the fifth foul resulting in player disqualification. Each team is allowed seven fouls per half, with the seventh foul resulting in a one-on-one foul-shooting bonus for the opposing team. Two technical fouls by one player in a game will result in player disqualification for that game. Flagrant fouls and physical and verbal abuse are not tolerated during league play. A player receiving more than two game ejections may be disqualified from the league. Fighting is not tolerated and may also result in league disqualification. Decisions to disqualify a player will be reviewed and decided upon by BASF.
- If a player receives three technical fouls during the season it will result in a 1 game suspension. If that player receives a fourth technical during the season will result in 2 game suspensions and BASF holds the right to consider if player will be allowed back next season. If that player receives a fifth technical will result in a league disqualification.
- All other rules will follow NCAA format unless indicated by the referee.

III. Playoffs

- Playoffs will begin September 2024. See Schedule for Playoff Format.
- Seeding for the playoffs will be decided by overall record. The team with the best record will receive the #1 seed seeding format will follow with the next best record.
- In the event of equal records, head to head competition for teams that are tied will determine the seeding. If a team's record is the same against one another, then tie breakers will be decided with records against the top team in the league.

IV. Referees

• Referees make and enforce the final calls in all games. Please respect all decisions made by the referees. Verbal and/or physical abuse toward a referee is prohibited and may result in league disqualification.

V. Jerseys

does not have his or her own jersey to wear that team will receive a technical foul and the opposing team
may elect to take a two-shot technical foul prior to the start of the game.
